At the December meeting of the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee, Council Members discussed changes to the starting times for the City Council's meetings and committees. In addition, at the direction of the committee, the City's Marketing and Communications Department posted a survey on January 3<sup>rd</sup> to seek feedback from citizens regarding potential changes to the City Council's meeting times. Based on the committee's discussion and subsequent feedback from the Mayor and Council Members, City management recommends changing the starting time for the City Council's zoning and regular business meetings on the first and third Mondays of each month from 7 p.m. to 6 p.m. In addition, City management recommends changing the order and starting times for the Public Safety Committee to 2 p.m. and the Finance Committee to 4 p.m. on the second Monday of each month. The order and starting times for the Public Works Committee would change to 2 p.m. and the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee to 4 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month. The attached amendment to City Code Section 2-33 and resolution would implement these changes. Prior to the committee's consideration of these changes, staff will present the results of the survey. If approved, the changes in meeting order and times would be effective on February 1, 2023.

Proposed changes for the City Council 2023 meeting schedule include the following:

### **January**

Due to the City holiday for New Year's Day occurring on Monday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, the first City Council meeting will need to change to Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Due to Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the second City Council meeting will need to change to Tuesday, January 17<sup>th</sup>.

#### June

Due to the Juneteenth Holiday, the second City Council meeting will need to change to Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>.

#### <u>July</u>

All meetings (City Council and Committee meetings) for July 2023 will be cancelled for a July recess.

### September

Due to the Labor Day Holiday, the first City Council meeting will need to change to Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>.

### November

Due to the Thanksgiving Holiday, the second City Council meeting will be moved to Monday, November  $27^{\rm th}$ .

## <u>December</u>

City Council will meet for the Zoning Meeting and all Committee meetings. The second full City Council meeting will be cancelled. All Committee items will carry over to the first City Council meeting of the new year on Tuesday, January 2, 2024.

The proposed changes are listed in red, and the Budget meetings are listed in blue on the attached 2023 Meeting Schedule. The new meeting times would start with the February meetings.
