It is recommended that a contract for mowing services be awarded to Crawford Landscaping, Inc. in the annual amount of \$61,840 with option to extend for one additional year, for a total potential value of \$123,680.

The Vegetation Management FY 2022-23 operations budget includes sufficient funds to cover these contracts through June 30, 2023. Funding for the remainder of the 2023 mowing season as well as for any future extensions is subject to future budget appropriations.
