## Summary of Information:

The City of Winston-Salem is a grantee of the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program beginning July 1, 2021. The HOPWA allocation for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2021 of $\$ 710,304$ was appropriated through the City's 2021-2022 annual budget. The City issued a request for proposal for a Project Sponsor to carry out the program in the five-county service area (Forsyth, Davie, Davidson, Stokes and Yadkin Counties). Positive Wellness Alliance was the only applicant and submitted a proposal for $\$ 588,048$. The Mayor and City Council approved Positive Wellness Alliance as Project Sponsor in November 2021. The item also stated that staff would return to Council for approval to spend the balance of the HOPWA grant when a request was submitted to the City. Positive Wellness Alliance has been carrying out the HOPWA program and has assisted 256 individuals with housing services through June 2022.

Positive Wellness Alliances has requested the balance of the FFY 2021 HOPWA grant of $\$ 122,256$. Expenditure of the funds is outlined in the table below. An appropriate resolution is attached.
