Summary of Information: Winston Summit, LP, a North Carolina limited partnership, or an affiliated or related entity (Borrower), is seeking financing for a portion of the costs to acquire, rehabilitate and equip the affordable multifamily residential rental facility known as Winston Summit Apartments (Development). The Development is located at 137 Columbine Drive and consists of 100 units.  The financing will take the form of multifamily housing revenue bonds, in an amount not to exceed \$13,089,000 (Bonds). The Housing Authority of Winston-Salem (Issuer) has tentatively agreed to issue said bonds.  Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (Code), requires City Council approval of the financing plan before Bonds may be issued, and following a public hearing regarding the plan. Issuer held the required public hearing on March 29, 2023 and requests the City Council approve the issuance of the Bonds as Required by the Code.
