## **Special Use District Rezoning**

**UDO - XXX**

**AN ORDINANCE PROPOSED BY THE CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE  
AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES TO ADD  
NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHNAGE PROGRAM AS A USE**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, that the *Unified Development Ordinances* is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter A, Article II – Definitions is hereby amended as follows:

Article II – Definitions

**NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (W).** Any use of land which meets all the requirements of a needle and hypodermic exchange program set forth in G.S. 90-113.27.

**Section 2.** Chapter B, Article II, Section 2-4 – Permitted Uses is hereby amended as follows:

**Addition to TABLE B.2.6.**

**Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Program (W):** Insert a “Z” for every zoning district.

**Section 3.** Chapter B, Article II, Section 2-5 – Use Conditions is hereby amended as follows:

**2-5.55.1 NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (W)**

- (A)** **Permitted Only Through Special Use District Rezoning**  
**A Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Program, whether as a principal or an accessory use, shall only be permitted through the Special Use District Rezoning process described in either Section B. 6-2.1 or Section B.6-2.2.**

**(B)**     **Amortization of Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs**  
**Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs made nonconforming**  
**by the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be discontinued on or before June**  
**1, 2019.**

**(C)**     **Compliance With Applicable Laws**  
**Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs shall comply with all**  
**applicable local, state and federal laws.**

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
