### AN ORDINANCE PROPOSED BY THE CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES TO ADD NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHNAGE PROGRAM AS A USE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, that the *Unified Development Ordinances* is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter A, Article II – Definitions is hereby amended as follows:

# **NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (W).** Any use of land which meets all the requirements of a needle and hypodermic exchange program set forth in G.S. 90-113.27.

Section 3. Chapter B, Article II, Section 2-5 – Use Conditions is hereby amended as follows:

### 2-5.55.1 NEEDLE AND HYPODERMIC SYRINGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (W)

(A)Elected Body Special Use Permit Approval Required<br/>Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs, whether as a principal<br/>or accessory use, shall only be permitted if approved through the Elected<br/>Body Special Use Permit Process.

- (B) <u>Amortization of Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs</u> <u>Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs made nonconforming</u> <u>by the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be discontinued on or before June</u> <u>1, 2019.</u>
- (C) Compliance With Applicable Laws Needle and Hypodermic Syringe Exchange Programs shall comply with all applicable local, state and federal laws.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
