SUBJECT: Draft Strategic Plan Review

At its January workshop, the Mayor and City Council created and ranked strategies to be adopted in the 2017-2021 Strategic Plan. Within each of the strategies identified by the Mayor and City Council, staff assigned action items to help move toward accomplishing the goals set forth in the strategies.

The next step in the strategic planning process includes review of the draft strategic plan by the Mayor and City Council. To facilitate review, the draft strategic plan will go to each committee to provide for systematic review of all strategies and associated action items. As the strategies have already been voted on (and thereby ranked) by the Mayor and City Council, this review is intended to focus on the creation and assignment of action items within the focus areas. Although committee members can choose to review any sections of the document, it is expected that committees will review those areas most aligned to the committee structure. The table below summarizes which sections the committees might focus on:

The City Council will provide feedback during the April committee meetings. Staff will make those changes and bring the plan back to the Mayor and City Council for adoption in May.
