SPECIAL USE DISTRICT PERMIT

Issued by the City Council

of the City of Winston-Salem

The City Council of the City of Winston-Salem issues a Special Use District Permit for the site shown on the site plan map included in this zoning petition of <u>Stephen Craver</u>, Trustee for the <u>Trust of Zula Veigh Craver</u>, (Zoning Docket <u>W-3331</u>). The site shall be developed in accordance with the plan approved by the Board and bearing the inscription: "Attachment A, Special Use District Permit for <u>Motor Vehicle, Repair and Maintenance</u>, approved by the Winston-Salem City Council the ______ day of _______, 20____" and signed, provided the property is developed in accordance with requirements of the <u>GB-S</u> zoning district of the Zoning Ordinance of the *Unified Development Ordinances*, the Erosion Control Ordinance, and other applicable laws, and the following additional conditions be met:

• PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS:

- a. An engineered lighting plan shall be submitted to Inspections for the proposed lighting demonstrating the use of full-cut off fixtures, light height of 25' or less and no more than 0.5 foot-candles at the property line.
- b. Developer shall obtain a driveway permit from the City of Winston-Salem Public Works Department.

• PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF OCCUPANCY PERMITS:

- a. Lighting shall be installed per approved lighting plan and certified by an engineer.
- b. Developer shall complete all requirements of the driveway permit.

• **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

- a. Freestanding signage shall be limited to one (1) six (6) foot high monument sign with a maximum copy area of thirty-six (36) square feet. Electronic Message Board Signs shall not be permitted.
- b. There shall be no exterior storage of inoperative motor vehicles or motor vehicles that are under repair.
- c. There shall be no improvements on PIN 6833-28-5349 with the exception of the proposed bufferyard and fence as shown on site plan.
