## RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A TRUCK MOUNTED CLOSED CIRCUIT CAMERA TRUCK SYSTEM

**WHEREAS**, G.S. 143-129(e) provides that formal bid procedures "shall not apply to purchases of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment when performance or price competition for a product are not available; when a needed product is available from only one source of supply or when standardization or compatibility is the overriding consideration"; and

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Department has established the need for a closed circuit camera truck system and has requested the Envirosight Rovver X truck system due to its durability, has simpler and more user-friendly technology than competitor's brands, and is compatible with existing equipment in use by Stormwater and City/County Utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works Equipment and Supply, Inc., the sole distributor for the Envirosight Rovver X truck system, has submitted quotations for the purchase and installation of the Envirosight Rovver X truck system which includes the RX130 Crawler with backeye camera totaling \$130,231.21; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Public Works Equipment and Supply, Inc. for the purchase and installation of an Envirosight Rovver X truck system per quotations in the amount of \$130,231.21.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that a purchase order for the purchase and installation of an Envirosight Rovver X truck system per quotation is hereby awarded to Public Works Equipment and Supply, Inc. in the amount of \$130,231.21.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualification of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to

perform the purchase order until the order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this purchase will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation and funding for the lease payments is available in the General Fund FY 2016-17 budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City may reimburse itself for the capital expenditures identified herein with the proceeds from the sale of tax-exempt obligations.
