Council Action Requested:

Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing Fee Simple Acquisition by the North Carolina Department of Transportation an Agency of the State of North Carolina Relating to the U.S. 421/Business 40 Pavement Reconstruction, Bridge Replacement, and Interchange Modification Project and Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 160A-274 (South Ward)

Summary of Information:

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is beginning the project to completely upgrade and streamline a one-mile section of U.S. 421/Business 40 from west of Fourth Street to east of Church Street in Winston-Salem. The State TIP Number U-2827B project will include removing the existing pavement and replacing it with new concrete pavement. The project will also modernize the entrance and exit ramps, and replace most of the bridges on and over Business 40 with new bridges that meet current traffic demands and modern design specifications. The project will create a safer, longer lasting roadway that will help drivers get where they need to go more efficiently.

NCDOT has made an offer of \$29,000 to purchase a vacant remnant lot known as Parcel 181 which is needed for the construction of the above project. This lot is further described in attached Exhibit A. The offer is believed to be reasonable for this vacant remnant lot. Judy Joines, the project manager for Right of Way Consultants, LLC, North Carolina Department of Transportation's acquisition agent, has further explained in Exhibit B, their need to move forward with the acquisition of Parcel 181.

N.C.G.S. 160A-274 permits such sales, and the attached resolution authorizes the sale of the property as described in the attached Exhibit A.
