WHEREAS, the low bid submitted by ErgoFlex Systems, Inc., dba Xybis Systems, Inc. and second lowest bid submitted by Watson Furniture Group, Inc. failed to meet bid specifications and cannot be considered for award; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order for the purchase and installation of 12 new console/dispatch workstations be awarded to Russ Bassett Corporation in the amount of \$191,058.60.
