STATEMENT OF CONSISTENCY  
UDO TEXT AMENDMENT 277 REVISING CHAPTER B ARTICLE IV OF THE *UNIFIED  
DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES* TO AMEND THE HISTORIC/HISTORIC OVERLAY  
REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE SMALL TOWNS WITHIN FORSYTH COUNTY’S  
HISTORIC RESOURCE COMMISSION (HRC)

UDO Text Amendment 277 is consistent with the *Legacy Comprehensive Plan* and approval of the same is reasonable and in the public interest because: (i) it promotes consolidation of individual Historic Resource Commissions in counties rather than each community having its own thereby adding the towns of Bethania, Lewisville, Rural Hall and Walkertown to the joint Historic Resources Commission (“HRC”) which already includes the town of Kernersville and Village of Clemmons; (ii) replaces language in the Purpose section with language consistent with the current state enabling legislation; (iii) changes representation on the HRC to include membership from the new members; and (iv) clarifies the makeup of the HRC and terms of office for members.
