Council Action Requested:

Consideration of a resolution authorizing contract for Hazen and Sawyer to perform engineering design and construction administration services for water quality improvement work at Washington Park in the amount of \$250,610.00.

Summary of Information:

Washington Park is a heavily used city park with multi-purpose trails as well as a dog park. The existing dog park enclosure is approximately 1.6 acres in size and is 100 feet away from Salem Creek. A retrofit of the dog park is needed to correct drainage issues and enhance the quality of water that runs off the park and into Salem Creek. In addition, a tributary to Salem Creek runs through the park. This tributary has stream banks that are severely eroded and threatens walking paths, infrastructure and other amenities in the park.

Engineering services are needed to design a stormwater control measure to reduce fecal coliform and turbidity loading to Salem Creek and improve the existing site drainage. In addition, designs and permits are needed for restoration of the tributary in order to protect walking paths, infrastructure and amenities in the area of the tributary.

Staff is requesting approval of a contract for Hazen and Sawyer in the amount of \$250,610.00 to provide engineering designs and specifications, obtain permits, bidding assistance and construction administration/oversight. Hazen and Sawyer is a local engineering firm with experience in water quality improvement projects.
