Historic Resources staff has reviewed the five properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on August 15, 2017 for demolition consideration. Below is a list of contributing structures in National Register of Historic Places districts.

Properties located in National Register Historic Districts: 2414 Waughtown Street - Waughtown/Belview Historic District

Historic Resources staff has concerns about the loss of structures in the City's National Register Historic Districts; however, in this case three of the five structures on the list have been destroyed by fire. 2414 Waughtown Street, the property listed in the Waughtown-Belview Historic District is one of those structures. Therefore, there is no request for further action due to the historic value of the properties.
