## **Summary of Information:**

The original easements for the installation and maintenance of the Little Creek Force Main were obtained in 1964. This easement crosses four parcels currently owned by Venn Hillcrest, LLC. The sewer lift station and the force main were abandoned when gravity sewer was made available. This has eliminated the need for the force main and its accompanying easements. The current property owner, Venn Hillcrest, LLC has requested the quitclaim abandonment of easements affecting its property as further described in Exhibit A.

The City/County Utility Commission and Staff are supportive of this request.

The attached resolution authorizes the quitclaim abandonment of public sewer easements and associated public sewer main fixtures for the Hillcrest Section Seven Project, as described herein.
