In April 2015, the Mayor and City Council approved an interlocal agreement with Forsyth County to share the services and cost of a City-County Geographic Information Office—MapForsyth. The agreement allocates the cost of MapForsyth based on the population of the City of Winston-Salem and all of Forsyth County, including the other municipalities. Currently, the County covers 64.5% of the cost of MapForysth, with the City covering the remaining 35.5%. A GIS Steering Committee oversees the work of MapForsyth. The committee includes the Forsyth County Tax Administrator, the County MIS Director, the City-County Planning and Development Services Director, the City's Chief Information Officer, the Assistant County Manager, and an Assistant City Manager.

Joseph Sloop, the City-County Geographic Information Officer, and his staff have prepared an annual report for FY 2016-2017 on MapForsyth, summarizing performance data, activities, and accomplishments over the past year. The report is attached for the Public Works Committee's review.
