## **Summary of Information:**

The Old Salem Infrastructure Bond Project scope was developed to address sidewalk safety, street tree health and longevity, and street lighting concerns. Two additional types of work were incorporated into the project through the design process for Stormwater and Water and Sewer Infrastructure.

The existing street lighting system is managed with a complicated partnership between the City, Old Salem, Inc., and Salem Congregation, and Duke Energy. The proposed plan develops a new street lighting system owned and maintained by the City. Easements are required to route power from Duke Energy transformers placed in discrete locations in the historic district to Church and Walnut Streets. A Stormwater easement is also required at the southern end of Church Street. An existing draining pipe crosses the corner of the property. There is not an existing easement and a portion of the pipe is in need of replacement. Old Salem, Inc. and Salem Academy and College have agreed to donate the easements necessary for this project.

The attached resolution authorizes the acquisition by donation from Old Salem, Inc. and Salem Academy and College of permanent easements as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
