Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing Acquisition of 13 Pay Stations to Replace the Existing 13 Pay Stations in Downtown.

Strategic Focus Area: Quality Transportation

Currently, there are 13 Luke II, multi pay stations located primarily near City Hall. The manufacturer of the existing pay stations has informed staff that effective March 2018 these pay stations will no longer be supported by them. Additionally the machines run on a Microsoft software which is no longer supported by Microsoft, therefore we may fall out of PCI compliance or no longer be able to accept credit card payments.

Replacement pay stations by Luke II typically costs \$15,400 per unit. However, due to the number of units to be replaced the supplier has reduced the cost to less than \$10,000 per unit. The replacement units will operate just like the old units. The replacement units will accept payment by coin, bills or credit cards and are also capable of receiving payment by phone when the city is ready to take advantage of that option.

Funding for the replacement pay stations were approved in the 2017-2018 capital improvement plan and are available.
