## RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR FORD INTERCEPTOR SUV'S

WHEREAS, after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 12:00 p.m., January 18, 2018, for the purchase of four Ford Interceptor SUV's per bid specifications as scheduled replacements for vehicles used by Winston-Salem Police Department K-9 officers and the following bids were received:

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Asheville Ford, LLC for the purchase of four Ford Interceptor SUV's per bid specifications at the cost of \$30,998.68 each for a total amount of \$123,998.72.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that a purchase order for four Ford Interceptor SUV's per bid specifications at the cost of \$30,998.68 each is hereby awarded to Asheville Ford, LLC in the total bid amount of \$123,998.72 and that all other bids are rejected.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualification of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the purchase order until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the purchase is included in the FY 2017-18 capital budget and will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation with funding for the lease payments available in the FY 2017-18 General Fund budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City may reimburse itself for the capital expenditures identified herein with the proceeds from the sale of tax-exempt obligations.
