Lighting is being used in transportation infrastructure projects. Lights have been applied to the railroad and Business 40 bridges along Research Parkway. Artistic architectural lighting is also on the twin arches over US 52 at Research Parkway and is a planned component on the Business 40 Project for the lighting of bridges. These are all part of the Architectural Lighting program. With lighting being utilized on more public infrastructure, city staff proposes a new policy for the approval process and for the lighting requirements for architectural lighting within the public rights-of-way.
