RESOLUTION DECLARING HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH IN WINSTON-SALEM, NORTH CAROLINA MAY 2018

- **WHEREAS**, the City of Winston-Salem joins cities and counties across the United States in a nationwide celebration of Historic Preservation Month, and;
