Summary of Information:

Traffic Field Operations of the Streets Division has the need to purchase five trench rollers as scheduled replacements for equipment that has exceeded its useful life. Trench rollers are used to compact backfill materials during street cuts and utility installations. Proper compaction of backfill is essential to prevent potential settlement issues that would create threats to the traveling public. The department currently has only one functioning roller. Bids were received March 29, 2018 for this equipment and below is a summary of the bids received:

The City's FY 2017-18 capital equipment budget includes \$144,900 for this purchase; therefore, it is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to H & E Equipment, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, for the purchase of five trench rollers at a total cost of \$140,875.

The purchase of these rollers will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation. Funding for the lease payments is available in the General Fund FY 2017-18 budget.
