

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ARCHITECTURAL LIGHTING POLICY FOR
DISPLAYS WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, Winston-Salem, as the City of Art and Innovation, has seen numerous public art lighting displays created by the University of North Carolina School of the Arts; and

WHEREAS, architectural lighting is being used in existing transportation infrastructure at two bridges over US 52 at Research Parkway; and

WHEREAS, architectural lighting is being utilized more frequently in public infrastructure projects including proposed to be used in the Business 40 Project; and

WHEREAS, there is no formal control policy for architectural lighting within the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, City staff proposes to create a policy to govern the approval process and lighting requirements for architectural lighting within the corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the proposed policy shall apply to all architectural lighting in public rights-of-way regardless of right-of-way owner; and

WHEREAS, the policy will allow requests for special lighting displays with restrictions during the month of December.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon recommendation of the Public Works Committee, does hereby adopt the Architectural Lighting Policy.
