






# FY 2018-19 Budget Highlights



#### ✓ No Tax Increase

• Tax rate will remain at 59.74 cents per \$100 of assessed value.

#### ✓ Full Implementation of a Market Pay Study

Beginning April 2019

### ✓ 2% Supplemental Pay for sworn police and certified firefighters

Effective January 1, 2019

#### ✓ Increase in the Minimum Wage to \$12.50 per hour

Beginning April 2019

#### ✓ Business 40 Mitigation Strategy (NCDOT) Grant

• \$7.2 million; enhanced bus service for 8 routes, park & ride lots, and ride home program

#### $\checkmark$ Further automation of rear to side loader trucks

Approximate savings of \$210,000 per year

#### ✓ Elimination of Commercial Dumpster Service

Ending Dec 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018; Approximate savings of \$300,000 in FY19 (half a year)
