Summary of Information: The attached Technical Corrections Ordinance Amendment, recommended for your approval, makes a number of changes to the Winston-Salem City Code. The Amendment, if adopted, will:

- 1. Make changes to several department names and titles that have been update recently;
- 2. Insert the required federal procurement language applicable to contacts involving the expenditure of federal funds, in whole or part;
- 3. Insert the City's Ethics Policy and a violation of local, state and federal laws as additional reasons for disqualifying a contractor from bidding on future city contracts;
- 4. Insert a policy statement regarding the use of the annexations statutes to achieve residency and change outdated titles;
- 5. Insert the statutory reference for assessing charges related to the clean-up of certain hazardous spills as a nuisance under G.S. 160A-193;
- 6. Set a date for the repeal and removal of the bulky container provisions;
- 7. Make it clear that removal of a city boot on a vehicle remains a criminal offense; and
- 8. Make it clear that the streets referred to in the abandoned vehicle provisions within the code are public streets consistent with state law.

The aforementioned changes are necessary for the reasons indicated above.
