
MOMS = DEMAND ACTION FOR GUN SENSE IN AMERICA

- Close deadly loopholes in our background check system that allows dangerous people like felons, domestic abusers and terrorists easy access to guns.
- Support reasonable limits on when, where and how loaded guns are carried and used in public places.
- Create enforceable laws to address gun trafficking and fraudulent purchases to keep illegal guns off our streets.

95 people die every day from gun violence. 6 of these people are 18 and under.

This means in one year, a total of 34,668 people die from gun violence. Of these deaths, 2,277 are children 18 and under.
