The proposed amendments to the FY 2018-19 budget ordinances authorize adjustments for the following purposes.

Appropriation of Grants and Other Revenues Received

□ The amount of FY 2017-18 program income generated from the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funds exceeded budgeted estimates by \$42,119.19 and \$273,463.20, respectively. The proposed amendment appropriates the additional program income from CDBG funds for public service and the HOME funds for single-family housing production.
