Planning staff will be giving an informational presentation on UDO-287 at the September 11, 2018 Community Development/Housing/ General Government Committee meeting. This text amendment is being proposed by Triangle Residential Options for Substance Abusers, Inc. (TROSA) to add a new use "Group Care Facility C (Therapeutic Community)" to the Unified Development Ordinances (UDO).

TROSA is a non-profit organization that operates a large long-term residential substance abuse facility in Durham, NC. TROSA is interested in opening a similar facility in the Triad, with the goal of accommodating up to two-hundred and fifty (250) people at the facility.

The proposed use is similar to the existing UDO uses Group Care Facility A & B - however, these uses only allow up to forty residents. As such, a new use classification (Group Care Facility C) is necessary to accommodate TROSA's desired 250-person facility. The proposed use would only be permitted in the GB (General Business) zoning district through Special-Use District Zoning, and various use conditions are also proposed for this use.
