Historic Resources staff has reviewed the five properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on October 9, 2018 for demolition consideration. There are no properties on the list that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Additionally, discussions at City Council and Council Committee meetings have indicated a concern for the loss of structures in historically African-American neighborhoods. These discussions are continuing, but for Council Members information, I have identified structures from the list that are in historically African-American neighborhoods as presented in the latest survey documentation, that are not currently National Register designated.
