Summary of Information:

The Reserve at Hickory Commons, LLC has plans to develop the property located at 1295 Hartman Plaza Drive. The construction of several buildings will require abandonment of approximately 299 linear feet of an existing 6 inch water main and 215 linear feet of an existing 8 inch sewer main. There are no services connected to the portion of the water and sewer mains to be abandoned or flow running through the existing sewer main. New water and sewer lines will be installed by the developer to serve the development. The current area requested for quitclaim abandonment is further described in the attached Exhibit A.

The City/County Utility Commission and Staff are supportive of this request.

The attached resolution authorizes the quitclaim abandonment of sewer main infrastructure and public sewer easements and associated public sewer main fixtures for The Reserve at Hickory Commons, LLC, as described herein.
