

**RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S DECLARATION OF A STATE OF  
EMERGENCY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF  
THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM**

**WHEREAS**, Mayor J. Allen Joines declared a State of Emergency, within the corporate limits of the city of Winston-Salem, on Friday, October 12<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm and effective Thursday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm until modified or rescinded due to the fact that Hurricane Michael inflicted damage across the state and caused severe flooding and wind damage in the city of Winston-Salem beginning on or about Thursday, October 11<sup>th</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor J. Allen Joines determined that there was an imminent threat of or existing conditions have caused widespread or severe damage, injury, loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor J. Allen Joines determined that declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered therein was necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor J. Allen Joines declared a State of Emergency pursuant to the authority vested in the Mayor under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 38, Section 38-2 of the City of Winston-Salem Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the Winston-Salem City Council properly convened a meeting within 24 hours of said declaration as required by Chapter 38, Section 38-2 of the City of Winston-Salem Code of Ordinances.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Winston-Salem City Council, based upon the foregoing, that the action taken by Mayor J. Allen Joines declaring a State of Emergency is hereby ratified.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Winston-Salem City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to modify, where warranted, the declaration of a State of Emergency without the necessity of a subsequent meeting of the Winston-Salem City Council, provided the Mayor within a reasonable time after said modification notifies the Winston-Salem City Council of the modification and the details of the same.

**FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Winston-Salem City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to terminate the State of Emergency as soon as circumstances warrant such without the necessity of a subsequent meeting of the Winston-Salem City Council, provided the Mayor within a reasonable time after said termination notifies the Winston-Salem City Council of said termination and the basis for such.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
