## **Summary of Information:**

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from Winston Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education to close and abandon a portion of a Eleventh Street off of Highland Avenue. Winston Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education wishes to consolidate the property and clean up the area to make the space more usable. The area petitioned for closure is a portion of Eleventh Street, located between Highland Avenue and US 52 - Liberty Street exit ramp. This right-of-way is approximately 760 feet in length. The area is bounded on the North by Tax PIN's 6836-50-2676.000 and 6836-50-6667.000, and on the South by 6835-59-2966.000 and 6836-50-5339.000.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning or Winston-Salem Department of Transportation concerns if this right-of-way is closed. No property owner would be denied access to their property if this petition is approved. There are public utilities located in this right-of-way, with which the City would need to retain easements. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.

Approval of the petitioner's request to close and abandon a portion of Eleventh Street located off of Highland Avenue is recommended.
