RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ENHANCED LIGHTING ALONG MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DRIVE AS PART OF THE STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (U-5539A)

WHEREAS, in 2014 the City of Winston-Salem entered into an agreement with NCDOT for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive Streetscape Improvements Project (U-5593A); and

WHEREAS, \$2,500,000.00 in STP-DA funding has been approved provided the municipality provides a local match of 20%; and

WHEREAS, the scope of this project included landscaping, pedestrian crosswalks, fencing, signage, public art, median improvements, and enhanced lighting; and

WHEREAS, the enhanced lighting portion of this project will require Duke Energy to install approximately 100 new poles and luminaires; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the installation of the enhanced lighting is \$345,000; and

WHEREAS, funds for these expenses have been previously appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that the City Manger and City Secretary are authorized to enter into a Service Agreement with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC for the installation of enhanced lighting as part of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive Streetscape Improvements.
