Summary of Information:

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds are appropriated to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population and is used for operating and capital assistance. The Winston-Salem's Urban area received an appropriation of the FTA Section 5307 funding in the amount of \$4,233,716 for FY 2017 and \$4,752,137 for FY 2018. The City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urban area.

The Winston-Salem Urban Area Transportation Advisory Committee approved the 2017 and 2018 apportionment to the three (3) eligible sub-recipients and JARC agencies for funding. Davidson County Transportation was approved for \$169,275 in FY 2017 and \$218,120 in FY 2018. Currently Davidson County Transportation will serve as a sub-recipient to the City of Winston-Salem for these funds.
