RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDERS FOR VEHICLE LIGHTING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, November 7, 2018, for vehicle lighting equipment used to upfit 26 police pursuit vehicles for the Winston-Salem Police Department and the following bid was received:

<u>City/State</u> <u>Total Bid</u> Ilderton Conversion Company High Point, NC 126,273.60

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Ilderton Conversion Company, low bidder meeting specifications, for the vehicle lighting equipment in the estimated amount of \$126,273.60.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that a purchase order for vehicle lighting equipment used to upfit 26 police pursuit vehicles is hereby awarded to Ilderton Conversion Company, in the estimated amount of \$126,273.60.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purchase is included in the FY 2018-19 capital budget and will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation with funding for the lease payments available in the FY 2018-19 General Fund budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City may reimburse itself for the capital expenditures identified herein with the proceeds from the sale of tax-exempt obligations.
