


## FY 2018-19 General Fund Estimated Year End

### FY 2019-20 Budget-to-Budget Changes



#### Highlights

EXPENDITURES	
Springsted Market Study Full Implementation (includes benefits)	\$4.3 million
Increase in Employee Compensation  - 2% average merit effective 7/1/19 = \$2.9M  - Increase minimum wage from \$12.50 to \$12.75 (no compression) = \$30,000  - Increase in employee (non-police) benefits/retirement 1% = \$500,000  - Increase in Police benefits by 3% = \$1.2M	\$4.6 million
2% Public Safety Supplemental Pay (effective January 1, 2020)	\$800,000
Information Systems (Cyber-security & Technology Maintenance/Upgrades)	\$800,000
Facilities: - Union Station operating costs, full year (\$42k) - Parkland Pool re-opening (\$32k) - Winston Lake Golf Course (\$203K) - Reynolds Park Management Fees (\$84k)	\$360,000
Vehicular Maintenance Increased Costs	\$235,000


Highlights

Property Taxes (FY20 assumes a 2.1% growth above estimated year-end)	\$3.7 million
Sales Taxes (FY20 assumes 3% growth-point of sale; 4% growth-per capita)	\$2.2 million
Utilities Sales Taxes (Electricity, Piped Natural Gas, etc.)	\$550,000
