Zoning Petition of Union Cross Moravian Church, Docket W-3395

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WINSTON-SALEM CITY ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Winston-Salem City Zoning Ordinance and the Official Zoning Map of the City of Winston-Salem, N.C. are hereby amended by changing from <u>AG</u> to <u>NB</u> the zoning classification of the following described property:

Being a portion of Tax PIN 6863-98-1887.00, located in the City of Winston-Salem, Forsyth County, North Carolina, which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe set in the westerly right-of-way line of Union Cross Road [SR 2643] at the southeasterly comer of Lot 54 of the John Chamelin Estate Subdivision, Section 1 (Plat Book 12, Page 124, Forsyth County Register of Deeds) [Forsyth County Tax PIN #6863-99-6215.00], said iron having North Carolina Grid Coordinates (NAD 83/2001) of North(y) = 839,174.88' and East(x) 1,669,669.42'; running thence with the westerly right-of-way line of Union Cross Road the following three (3) courses and distances: 1) South 29 deg 40' 55" West a distance of 27.76 feet to an NCDOT right-of-way disk found; 2) South 36 deg 28' 31" West a distance of 100.60 feet to an NCDOT right-of-way disk found; and 3) South 29 deg 41' 10' West a distance of 97.13 feet to a point; thence with a new line the following two (2) courses and distances: 1) North 53 deg 03' 41" West a distance of 104.23 feet to a point; and 2) North 28 deg 45' 40" East a distance of 146.93 feet to a point in the southerly line of said Lot 54 of the John H. Chamelin Estate Subdivision, Section 1; thence with the southerly line of said Lot 54 South 87 deg 37' 31" East a distance of 132.42 feet to the point and place of **BEGINNING**, containing 0.455 acres [19,821 Sq. Ft.], more or less, BEING located entirely upon that property described in Deed Book 494, Page 149, Forsyth County Register of Deeds Office.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
