## **Summary of Information:**

The Washington Park stream stabilization project scope was developed in order to improve erosion and water quality issues in the city-owned park. The unnamed tributary to Salem Creek is severely eroded, creating the need to restore the stream banks. This project will also retrofit the existing dog park to treat the runoff and remove pollutants before the water flows into Salem Creek.

Bids for this project were scheduled to be received on January 23, 2019, but less than three bids were offered as required at the initial bid opening for formal construction and repair contracts by North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) 143-132(a). Therefore, as authorized by N.C.G.S. 143-129, the project was re-advertised. Bids were then received February 7, 2019, with one bid received as follows:

North State Environmental, Inc.

The low bidder, North State Environmental, Inc., agreed to the M/WBE subcontracting goals established for this project of 10% with minority-owned businesses and 8% with women-owned businesses; therefore, it is recommended that a contract for the Washington Park stream stabilization project be awarded to North State Environmental, Inc., the low bidder meeting specifications, in the not-to-exceed total amount of \$747,745.76.
