WINSTON-SALEM CITY  
ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE  
OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

Section 1. The Winston-Salem City Zoning Ordinance and the Official Zoning Map of the City of Winston-Salem, N.C. are hereby amended by changing from HB and RSQ to GB-L (Arts and Crafts Studio; Banking and Financial Services; Child Care, Drop-In; Church or Religious Institution, Community; Church or Religious Institution, Neighborhood; Combined Use; Food or Drug Store; Furniture and Home Furnishings Store; Government Offices, Neighborhood Organization, or Post Office; Hotel or Motel; Institutional Vocational Training Facility; Library, Public; Museum or Art Gallery; Offices; Police or Fire Station; Restaurant (without drive-through service); Retail Store; School, Vocational or Professional; Services A; Urban Agriculture; Shopping Center; Shopping Center, Small; Storage Services, Retail; Adult Day Care; Child Care, Sick Children; Child Day Care Center; Life Care Community; Residential Building, Multifamily; Residential Building, Townhouse; Residential Building, Twin Home; Residential Building, Duplex; School, Private; and School, Public) the zoning classification of the following described property:

PIN#s 6825-81-1669 and 6825-81-2953

Section 2. This Ordinance is adopted after approval of the Special Use Limited District Permit issued by the City Council the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2019 to Krystal Corporation and Krystal Co. LLC.

Section 3. The City Council hereby directs the issuance of a Special Use Limited District Permit pursuant to the Zoning Ordinance of the *Unified Development Ordinances* for a development to be located on the property described in section one above. Said Special Use Limited District Permit with conditions is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
