Summary of Information:

It is necessary that a failed stormwater culvert be replaced beneath Macon Drive between University Parkway and Wake Place Court which is undermining the paved travel way. The work includes removal and replacement of the existing stormwater pipe and appurtenances within the public right-of-way and within the acquired easements. The project also entails the restoration of other affected public infrastructure features such as pavement, utilities, pavement markings and signage, etc. The easements and affected property owners are shown in the attached Exhibit A. These values are based on appraised values. If the property owner rejects the offer, then condemnation is authorized based on the appraised value.

The attached resolution authorizes staff to proceed with the acquisition of the easements as stated herein.
