## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FAIRLAWN DRIVE SIDEWALK PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City has plans to construct a sidewalk on Fairlawn Drive from Silas Creek

Parkway to Reynolda Road; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of this project is \$1,086,800; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2018, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning

Organization Transportation Advisory Committee approved the use of \$869,440 in Surface

Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds for this project; and

**WHEREAS,** federal STBG-DA funds require a 20% local match; therefore, the City is required to provide \$217,360 in local matching funds; and

WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), whereby the City will design and construct the project and NCDOT will reimburse the city for all eligible project expenses, up to \$869,440; and

**WHEREAS** The City's local match of \$217,360 is available from 2014 Bond Funds which are already appropriated.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem will allow the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Fairlawn Drive Sidewalk Project.
