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## RESOLUTION TO AUTHORRIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE COLISEUM DRIVE AND UNIVERSITY PARKWAY INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem Department of Transportation and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) have identified the Coliseum Drive and University Parkway intersection as an intersection with significant pedestrian safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of improving this intersection is \$245,000; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2018, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning

Organization Transportation Advisory Committee approved the use of \$125,000 in Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds for this project; and

WHEREAS, NCDOT's Federal Highway Safety Program will also contribute \$45,000 to

supplement the funding needed for this project; and

**WHEREAS,** the City will to contribute \$75,000 which includes the City's local match to the federal and state funds awarded for this project; and

WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the NCDOT, whereby the City will design and construct the project and NCDOT will reimburse the city for all eligible project expenses, up to \$170,000; and

**WHEREAS** the City's contribution of \$75,000 is available from 2014 Bond Funds which are already appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem will allow the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Coliseum Drive and University Parkway intersection improvement project. Page 105.
