Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Silas Creek Parkway Sidewalk Project.

Summary of Information:

The City has plans to construct a sidewalk on Silas Creek Parkway from Bolton Street to Lockland Avenue. The total estimated cost of this project is \$3,210,000. On May 17, 2018, the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Advisory Committee approved the use of \$1,126,400 in Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds for this project. The approved amount is to supplement \$396,000 in Federal funding approved through North Carolina Department of Transportation's (NCDOT) Prioritization process 4.0 bringing the total federal amount obtained so far to \$1,522,400. The City intend to request the balance (\$1,045,600) from NCDOT. All Federal funds require a 20% local match; therefore, the City is required to provide \$642,000 in local matching funds.

The attached resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the NCDOT, whereby the City will design and construct the project and NCDOT will reimburse the City for all eligible project expenses, up to \$2,568,000. The City's local match of \$642,000 is available from 2014 Bond Funds which are already appropriated.
