RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR A PILOT PROGRAM FOR TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT PLANNING - SECTION 20005b FUNDING THROUGH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) announced a funding opportunity called the Pilot Program for Transit-Oriented Development Planning; and

WHEREAS, in March, 2018 the Mayor and City Council gave staff authorization to apply for this grant; and

WHEREAS, the FTA has announced that the city of Winston-Salem has been award a grant up to \$1,000,0000; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to develop a comprehensive study to explore zoning and land use recommendations that are vital for streetcar development, business retention/development, housing and neighborhood impacts strategies, as well funding and marketing opportunities/strategies; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work includes additional emphasis on evaluating opportunities within the corridor area for more multimodal options including greenways, sidewalks and multiuse facilities; and

WHEREAS, the match required is \$200,000, which is 20%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements for the Pilot Program TOD Planning funds totaling \$1,000,000.
