Summary of Information:

The Maintenance Division of the Recreation Department has the immediate need to replace a drum roller used to perform maintenance in parks throughout the City. This roller is used by Recreation construction crews on a daily basis to compact walking trails throughout the park system and is a requirement for the proper maintenance of the trails. The current drum roller, equipment #2038, is a 1989 Case 602-B with a purchase cost of \$44,558 and maintenance and repair costs of \$19,442.

On May 18, 2019, the North Carolina Sheriff's Association, a cooperative purchasing group, awarded a contract for heavy equipment and National Equipment Dealers, LLC d/b/a May/RHI of Lexington, NC was awarded competitive bid contract #19-03-0504R per bid specifications. National Equipment Dealers, LLC d/b/a May/RHI has offered a quotation for a new Bomag BW177D-5 single drum roller that meets specifications required by the City in the total amount of \$106,745.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."
