THIS AGREEMENT, made this _____day of _____, 20___, and between **BROOKBERRY FARM RESIDENTIAL OWNERS MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC.**, a North Carolina non-profit corporation (hereinafter the "Association") and the CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM, NORTH CAROLINA, a municipal corporation (hereinafter the "City"):

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Association and the City entered into an Agreement on March 27, 2006; and

WHEREAS, in that original Agreement, the Association agreed to reimburse the City for all additional charges and expenses which the City incurred for seventy (70) decorative luminaries for the streetlighting system in Brookberry Farm; and

WHEREAS, Brookberry Farm expanded in January 2008 and June 2014 for an additional one hundred ninety-eight (198) streetlights; and

WHEREAS, Brookberry Farm has expanded and additional streetlights are necessary; and

WHEREAS, due to the expansion, the current total of decorative streetlights for which the Association will be responsible for reimbursement to the City will increase from one hundred ninety-eight (198) to two hundred forty (240).

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth, the City and the Association agree as follows:

- 1. The Agreement dated March 27, 2006 is hereby amended to provide that the lighting system for which the Association is responsible for reimbursement, as provided in the Agreement, consist of two hundred forty (240) decorative luminaries.
- 2. Except as herein provided, the remaining provisions in the March 27, 2006 Agreement remain unchanged.
