## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Association and the City entered into an Agreement on June 2, 2003; and

WHEREAS, in that original Agreement, the Association agreed to reimburse the City for all additional charges and expenses which the City incurred for THIRTY-SEVEN (37) decorative luminaries for the streetlighting system in Villas at Peace Haven II; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the expansion, the current total of decorative streetlights for which the Association will be responsible for reimbursement to the City will increase from THIRTY-SEVEN (37) to SIXTY-THREE (63).

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth, the City and the Association agree as follows:

- 1. The Agreement dated June 2, 2003 is hereby amended to provide that the lighting system for which the Association is responsible for reimbursement, as provided in the Agreement, consist of SIXTY-THREE (63) decorative luminaries.
- 2. Except as herein provided, the remaining provisions in the June 2, 2003 Agreement remain unchanged.
