RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SAMET CORPORATION FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS TO RELOCATE THE EXISTING TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROL CABINET AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIFTH STREET AND PATTERSON AVENUE

WHEREAS, Samet Corporation has requested that the traffic signal control cabinet at Fifth Street and Patterson Avenue be relocated because the existing traffic signal cabinet is prohibiting the aesthetics and access to the proposed development; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation staff recommends that this work be performed by the City of Winston-Salem Traffic Signal Maintenance staff given that the equipment has been under city maintenance for over four years and cannot be placed under warranty; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost for the relocation of the existing traffic signal control cabinet is \$6,568.10; and

WHEREAS, Samet Corporation has agreed to pay the full cost of the relocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon the recommendation of the Finance Committee, do hereby authorize the City Manager and City Secretary to enter into an agreement with Samet Corporation for the acceptance of funds to relocate the traffic signal cabinet at the intersection of Fifth Street and Patterson Avenue.
