Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Approve a Change Order to the Old Salem Infrastructure Improvements project with Ramey, Inc. for Construction Services Related to the Rehabilitation and Renovations to the Strollway Pedestrian Facility

Summary of Information:

The 2018 Bond Referendum allocated the funds for several transportation related improvement projects. Part of those funds were earmarked for the Strollway Renovations Project. This project includes resurfacing approximately 6,000 linear feet, utility structure adjustments, lighting system improvements, bridge and handrail repairs and tree trimming in certain locations.

A change order to the Old Salem Infrastructure Improvements project would be beneficial for consistency of work in this area. Similar work is being performed by the Ramey Inc. in Old Salem. Staff desires that one contractor be used for both projects to ensure the final road treatments look consistent.

Ramey Inc. has agreed to accept the additional work and provided a scope and fee not-to-exceed \$604,420.37. Adequate funds are available in the account established for this project.
