WINSTON-SALEM CITY COUNCIL Regular Virtual Meeting April 20, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Joines called the Virtual Meeting of the City Council to order at 7:00 pm and asked the City Secretary to call the roll.

ROLL CALL
